- [1] "Size" refers to the internal diameters of pipe that may be lined with Neofit PET liner.

 The PET liner itself is available in unexpanded sizes of 7 mm 20 mm.
- [2] Evaluated for Immediate Return to Service.
- [3] Certified for use as an expandable pipe repair liner when installed in accordance with the following expansion process:

Liner is inserted into pipe and then heated water is run through the lined pipes to expand the liner. Once the pipe has expanded, compressed air is run through pipes until the temperature drops. The cycle is completed in approximately 30 minutes. The temperature of the water and time for each step is dependent on the actual conditions at the time of installation (i.e., section length, diameter of pipe, depth of pipe in the ground, and ambient temperature conditions). The parameters for correct installation process are covered in detail in the installation manual.
